

## Editorial-Happy Stereoscopic New Year 2024

The year 2024 will take support on the partnerships established in 2023 with other associations in the field of photography and 3D- CLEM Patrimoine in Bordeaux, the Niépce-Lumière Club, the Iconomécanophiles du Limousin, the Courant 3D Festival- as much as on the already well-established partnerships with Intégrale Image association for the Gaillac 3D Festival and the fairs of Bièvres, Chelles and Aulnay-de-Saintonge.

The Club will keep on supporting members' initiatives, such as the introduction to stereoscopy at the Science City of La Villette in Paris, as well those as in Arles, Bordeaux, Colmar, Marseille, Saint-Anthème, Sablé-sur-Sarthe.

The 2024 calendar will alternate physical meetings and videoconference meetings, divided between technical meetings and presentation of images:

- First Wednesday of the month: videoconference on a technical subject,
- · Second Wednesday: Parisian meeting in Charenton-le-Pont,
- Third Wednesday: videoconference: presentation of 3D images,
- Fourth Wednesday: Parisian screening in Charenton-le-Pont.

I hope to see even more of you in the conference/meetings than in 2023!

The Nouvelle-Aquitaine regional group will continue, at its own pace, its technical meetings and screening sessions.

With the board of directors, I wish you many great stereoscopic and 3D discoveries. Do not hesitate to share with us your wonders and your creations, in the form of texts and still or animated images.

The Monthly Letter and the online site are widely open to you, for a few lines, two or three images or more. We are eager for new visions and remain curious to see how those of our regular contributors evolve.
