

Editorial - The French Stereo Club Archives & Collections

Dear members

Our archives and collections include:

- ! a library of more than 300 books on stereoscopy;
- ! several sets of our Newsletter series, since 1904:
- ! thousands of images on glass plates, cards or films (dias);
- ! cameras, projectors, viewers and other devices re. Stereocopy and 3D;
- ! paper archives re. the life and history of our club.

These images and these antique devices are currently stored in the reserves of the Bry-sur-Marne museum, run by the town council. Lately the mayor of Bry wrote us that he would not renew the current storage agreement, ending on January 31, 2022.

Our heritage is quite unique from a historical, scientific and cultural viewpoint. It is also, as a whole, an invaluable witness of the life of the only French stereoscopic club for over a century.

This has been recognised by Gilles Désiré Dit Gosset, director of the Médiathèque de l'architecture et du patrimoine (MAP, the french Media library on French monuments & heritage). Thus the MAP will likely host the whole set of our archives and collections, for which we thank warmly its director. We are working with the help of the heritage commission under an assignment by the club' managing board to draft a contract that would suit both parties. The Stereo-Club retains ownership of the physical objects and the attached rights while the Map stores and preserves them under professional conditions.

I thank the members of the heritage commission and of the Board of Directors for their cooperation in order to preserve and enhance the Stereo-Club' heritage


