Dear members,

October will be rich of 3D or "with 3D" events. On Wednesday October 4, 2023, during an SCF videoconference, JackDesBwa will present the stereopix.net site that he created. This site enables you to publish stereo pictures in various formats (side by side, anaglyphs, interlaced, etc.) and to exchange views between authors. You will get sufficient details for using the site to share your images .

The SCF Nouvelle-Aquitaine regional group meets on Sunday October 8 in Blanquefort. In the morning, projects for 2024 will be presented, technical exchanges will also take place. In the afternoon, a screening session of new productions by its members is scheduled.

The Courant 3D Festival will take place like every year in Angoulême, this year from October 10 to 15. Particularly worth watching are the short films presented on Thursday 12 from 2 to 4 p.m. and Friday 13 from 2:30 p.m. to 3 p.m. If you are eager to see more about AI (artificial intelligence) and fond of new visions, the film "Anselm" by Wim Wenders will be presented before its official release from 4 to 6 p.m. Wim Wenders is a filmmaker who practices stereoscopy in his own way.

Stereopsia will take place in Brussels from October 18 to 20, 2023. It is an international forum dedicated to immersive technologies and their content, aimed at professionals. Watch out for the European XR Awards.

Like every year, Café Photo Marseille presents its collective exhibition from October 14 to 29 at "3013", 52 rue de la République 13002 Marseille, on the theme "Oxymore" for the exhibition and "Mystère" for the screening sessions. On the program: Polaroid transfer workshop, introduction to Editing, portfolio reading, "M42" photo outing, "stereoscopy" photo outing, conference and image analysis, photo safari and "Photo Café" meeting. Multiple workshops and outings are led by the collective Les Alternati, members of Café Photo Marseille, and Philippe Garcin-Marcon, member of the French Stereo Club.

November will start with the first meeting of our Club with the Club des Iconomécanophiles du Limousin in Sablé-sur-Sarthe on November 4 and 5. Numerous cameras will be displayed including rare stereoscopic devices. For more information, please contact me - patrick.demaret.92@gmail.com.
